To apply for a zoning permit for a residential building from Williamsburg Township you will need the following:

- 1. Site plan with dimensions.
- 2. Show on site plan where any existing buildings are located.
- 3. Show where the new building will be with dimensions of the building.
- 4. Show on the site plan how far it is to any property line. Setbacks from each property line are as follows:
 - A. For front setback, measure from right-of-way to front line of building:
 - 1. 60' if Federal or State highway
 - 2. **50'** if County or Township roadway
 - B. For side setbacks, each need to be a minimum of **12'** from property line to building line.
 - C. For back setback, it needs to be a minimum of **30'** from property line to building line.

All of the above will be used on the application form.
