

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes March 14, 2013

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Thursday March 14, 2013 to transact business for a special meeting. Chairman Bainum called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson and Frank Harmon.

Frank Harmon from Ohio Insurance Services Agency said that he has had several conversations with Mr. Carson over the past couple of weeks. He presented several plans. He said that he feels that Medical Mutual of Ohio is offering the most comprehensive plan of all of the carriers. He said that rates are locked for 1 year and he is planning to try to create a large consortium next year with all of his government clients to give a huge buying power. He said that he thinks this will be very beneficial for all involved. He said that there is a lot of uncertainty with the Affordable Health Care Act that take effect in 2015. He said that we have been clients for almost 20 years and if we commit to staying with his company, he will reduce our HRA administration fees by 50%. The trustees asked many questions and he answered them as health insurance is very complicated and each plan offered varies greatly. The trustees thanked him for the long relationship and commitment to lower the HRA administration fees. The trustees agreed that MMO appears to have the cost comprehensive plan that they have seen and like the idea of a huge consortium to be a part of. The trustees agreed that staying with them allows for seamless transition in how the HRA plan is administered. The trustees agreed that with this change, we should see savings of around 45-50% over our current Anthem plan and will actually have better coverage. Mr. Jordan motioned to change insurance carriers from Anthem to Medical Mutual of Ohio and to remain with Ohio Insurance Services Agency as the broker and to continue to fund the HRA as is currently funded effective April 1, 2013. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Mr. Jordan motioned to adjourn at approximately 6:00 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
