

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

May 12, 2014

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday May 12, 2014 to transact business. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Yvonne Malott, Brian Tatman, Ken Wylie and Ed Boll.

Mr. Bainum motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Mr. Boll reported that he attended a Clermont County Transportation Improvement District meeting last Friday and he said that they said that they had passed a resolution in March to work on Half Acre Road. Mr. Henning explained that there was some discussion on the ditch in front of Ed Boll's house at the last meeting and said that the township can't spend money on private property unless it is affecting the roadways. He also explained that Mr. Boll's property sits on a state road and not a township road, so the right of ways is the state's responsibility.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. Mr. Bainum said that a resident had problems with a creek bank eroding and wanted to know what the township could do. Mrs. Malott said that this property owner called and she said that she told them that they need to contact the soil and water department at the county to see if they can give them advice on what to do, however the township can't do anything with private property. Mrs. Malott said that the cell tower on Half Acre Road will be upgraded soon. She said that Shirley Fee asked if the property across the street from her is going to be torn down soon. Mr. Henning said that he will contact the county to find out if they are going to do it soon. Mrs. Malott gave the trustees some information on mowing requirements that she got from our assistant prosecutor. The trustees asked her to get some more information from other townships to see what resolutions that is in place. Mr. Jordan said that he will contact the Ohio Township Association to see what they have.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that they fixed the flag pole at the cemetery. He said that they are still mowing constantly as grass is growing fast. He said that they have 3 more foundations to put in soon. Mr. Tatman asked what we planned to do with the old International dump truck. The new one will be delivered any time around September or October. Mr. Henning said that we can sell it via sealed bids or auction and since we don't have anything else to auction, a sealed bid makes most sense. The trustees think that we should probably do this around July so that it's hopefully sold before the new one arrives. Mr. Henning said that another township contacted him about possibly buying it and asked Mr. Tatman to contact them. Mr. Tatman said that they will mow the hike/bike trail down to the bridge before Memorial Day.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wylie said that he talked to Dr. Kahn and he is happy with the insurance that the township has already in place to cover his duties as Medical Director for the township. He said that he is investigating prices for uniforms or clothes for the EMS so that they look the same and professional.

Mr. Jordan motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:50 p.m. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.
