

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

October 10, 2016

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday October 10, 2016 to transact business. Chairman Bainum called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Richard Malott, Yvonne Malott, Kevin Wiedemann, Ed Boll and Brian Tatman.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. She said that the person who purchased Abrams Airfield is planning to add a storage building and plans to build gyrocopters. She said that she is working with the county prosecutor about whether or not it will need to be rezoned. Mr. Jordan said that he received a postcard saying that the Schumacher homes at the corner of State Route 32 and McKeever were going to be auctioned. Mrs. Malott said that the land is zoned business. She said that there are a lot of steps involved if someone would want to convert it to residential. She said that she is putting the legal notifications for next week's zoning board meeting on Tuesday October 18 at 7 p.m.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that they have had 57 funerals YTD. He said that they did the blacktop repairs in the Commons of Eastfork Subdivision and the repairs look really good. He said that the road has a big dip all the way back that he will continue to watch it. He said that everything that they have fixed so far is holding very well. He said that the summer part time help end on October 31. He said that they are mowing while he and Mr. Burba are doing ditch work. He said that all of the salt bins are full and ready to go when winter comes. He said that the county turned in the road specs for the new roads to the commerce park and they should be starting very soon. He said that the repairs are complete on the culverts on Hageman's Crossing Road. Mr. Bainum said that Greg Morgan wants to put in another culvert driveway pipe next to the current one and Mr. Tatman suggested that they get the exact same pipe and it would band together well. Mr. Bainum asked them to look at the ditches on Ireton Road by Gary Smith's house to see what they can do and he also asked him to look at Rick Wright's ditch.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann said that they are having an open house on Wednesday from 6 to 8. Mr. Bainum said that a township resident told him that our EMS was top notch and appreciated everything they did on a recent EMS call.
