SR 32 Corridor - Williamsburg Township

The Trustees have met with the Village Council recently discussing SR 32 from SR 133 to the Brown County line. We are in the very preliminary stages of the discussion. We met after the meeting at the Williamsburg High School to discuss the comments submitted and how those comments fit into the whole system. There were many very good and concerned comments that so far have been incorporated into the thinking and plans for 32.

We are now looking at the utilities along SR 32 and how to provide the correct utilities to encourage growth that helps the area rather than haphazard growth. Another meeting is planned during the summer that will take comments on further planning. As an example of further planning the zoning commission recently recommended that the land use from SR 133 to Brown County is Commercial and Industrial. Land use is not zoning and is an indication of proposed use not the actual zoned use. Land use plans can be changed very easily and should not be considered what will be rather what is planned to be.

Recently, the Trustees met with the company employed by the County. As talked about this is a look at the utilities such as water and sewage. Several suggestions were made.

The consultants will be presenting access, utilities, and land use at the next meeting during the summer. The time and date for this meeting has not been set so be sure to be watching for that meeting. By attending you will be helping to plan the future of Williamsburg Township. We need you suggestions and ideas.

The following information is about the make up of the Williamsburg Township Emergency Services.

On the EMS / Life squad side we have a full time paid Medic and EMT that work from 10am until 6pm Monday thru Friday. From 6pm until to 10am Monday thru Friday is covered by Volunteers. We have part time Medics and EMTs, that work from 6am Saturday until 6am Monday.

The Fire division consists of two full time Firefighter / EMTs from 8am until 5pm Monday thru Friday. All other times and positions are covered by Volunteer Firefighters. The Fire Chief is a part time position.

Membership make-up trained Firefighters (18), trained Firefighter / EMT (11), trained Firefighter / Medic (9), trained Paramedic (5), & trained EMT (3) for a total of 46 Members. These members are required to put in many hours of training each year, along with meetings, and fund raisers, for which they do not receive any monies for.

For the year 2007 we responded to 842 life squad runs and 305 fire runs.

From the Cemetery Sexton and Road Maintenance Supervisor —

The Williamsburg Township 2008 Clean Up schedule has been set. This year we will once again have spring clean up and a fall clean up. The dates for spring clean up are June 5, 6 & 7, 2008 and the fall clean up dates are October 2, 3 & 4, 2008. Please note these dates on your calendar, especially the October dates.

- Dumpster hours for Thursday and Friday (June 5 & 6 & October 2 & 3) will be from 8:00 a.m. 8:00 p.m. and Saturday (June 7 & October 4) from 8:00 am. -- 4:00 p.m.
- The dumpsters will be located at the end of North 8th St., between the cemetery and the Dualite Building.
- No batteries, units containing refrigerants, or chemicals will be accepted.
- The Township will be able to accept up to three tires of any size from each resident at no charge.
