

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees

February 12, 2007

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday February 12, 2007 to transact business. Chairman Taylor called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. James Danbury and Jim Taylor answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Earl Whiteman and Yvonne Malott.

Mr. Danbury motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Danbury motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report:

Mr. Whiteman said that the light at McKeever Schoolhouse and McKeever is a Duke Energy light and they said that they would fix it within 10 days. He said that all equipment is up and running. He said that Auto & Truck of Burg did transmission work on the F550, because they had problems during the last snow storm.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. Mr. Danbury asked what Tim Hershner asked about outdoor furnaces and she said that he was concerned about people burning wood outside in an outdoor furnace. Mr. Danbury asked what was happening with the property on East Main Street that she is having problems with junk and she said that she is still working on it. She said that she is trying to get help from the Clermont County Board of Health, but they aren't doing much. Mr. Danbury asked what Len Koogler wanted with racing. She said that someone wants to put in a ½ mile track to test electric cars and she explained the zoning requirements and told him that he would need a variance in any zoning district that the township currently has. Mr. Danbury said that he attended a meeting with the County discussing an industrial park on the land across from the Ford Plant. He said that the owners of the property were at the meeting also. He said that the county wants to apply for a \$2 million grant that would allow for industrial uses also.
