

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

March 9, 2015

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday March 9, 2015 to transact business. Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Kevin Wiedemann, Yvonne Malott, Brian Tatman and Ed Boll.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. Mr. Jordan asked about Mr. Dearing's mailbox being knocked down twice by the county engineer while plowing snow. She said that she gave him the county engineer's phone # and she plans to follow up with him to make sure the county took care of it. She said that a couple zoning board members are/have expired and she is contacting them. Mr. Henning motioned to renew Virgil Burroughs as a zoning board member for a 5 year term expiring 12-31-19. Mr. Bainum second. Mr. Bainum motioned to renew Kevin Thomas a zoning board alternate for a 2 year term expiring 12-31-16. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that the new truck is doing an excellent job. He said that we should be getting delivery of replacement salt pretty soon. The trustees thanked him for doing a great job with the snow removal. Mr. Tatman said that the 1 ton truck has a leak around the hydraulics and they are going to look at it tomorrow. He gave a copy of the resolution that the county needs in order to allow us to participate in their bidding. Mr. Henning motioned to approve Resolution #1-15 authorizing the county commissioners to coordinate resurfacing/repair of Cobb Road at a cost estimate not to exceed \$71,996.71. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Tatman said that they had 8 funerals in February and 2 already this month. He said that this is his monthly county meeting with the county engineer is this week. He said that he wants to bring Perry Bennett and Joe Morgan back this summer for mowing in the cemetery and other various duties starting part time around April 1 and ending around October 31.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Jordan said that he sent the new application document to our assistant prosecutor. He said that he plans to meet with him and make the minor recommendations for changes to them when the attorney lets him know. Mr. Wiedemann said he would like to send Duane Willis to a 2 day class for Fire/Arson Fatality Fire Scene at a cost of around \$375 and he would like to send Mike Hoh to a 1 day EMS leadership development class at a cost of around \$270. Mr. Jordan motioned to send Duane Willis to the Fire class at a cost of around \$375. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Henning motioned to send Mike Hoh to an EMS leadership class at a cost of around \$270. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Wiedemann said that he will be taking off March 19 and 20 for his daughter's surgery. He said that they would like to create an Emergency Services website and brought an example of a Demo Fire & Rescue Company website and the cost will be about \$25/month. He said that they can communicate amongst the members with their own email accounts and also put a lot of good information for the community on the website. The trustees agree that this is a good idea. Mr. Wiedemann said that he was asked to go to a meeting with other townships in the county in regards to joining a collaborative, but he has some reservations about the motivations of these townships, so he is going to look into it further but doesn't think it's going to work for us since it's the northern counties involved and northern Brown County.

Mr. Jordan reminded everyone that Marlon and Jessie Abrams would be honored tomorrow night at the Clermont Chamber Salute to Leaders for everything they do for Williamsburg Township.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 8:25 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
