

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

April 4, 2011

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday April 4, 2011 for a special meeting. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Richard Malott and Ken Wylie.

Mr. Henning said that we were meeting to discuss suggestion made by the assistant prosecutor in regards to the separation of the Williamsburg Township Emergency Services and the "association". The prosecutor spelled it out very nicely and said that their needs to be a wall of separation between the two. The trustees feel that the wall is there, because the association incorporated as a 501C3 corporation in 1996 as Williamsburg Township Emergency Services, Inc. However the Standard Operating Guidelines for the township was intermingled with the association's guidelines, so a line must be drawn. Everyone agreed that most of it was very minor and mostly on paper, because they have operated separately for years. After much discussion everyone agreed that things could be taken care of.

Mr. Malott said that he has been hearing several complaints about various things around the emergency services building. After much discussion, everyone agreed that these complaints were going to be looked into and solved as best as possible. The trustees agreed that Mr. Wylie is doing a good job in his first year and still is learning about the job and they continue to support him.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 8:45 p.m. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.
