

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

April 27, 2015

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday April 27, 2015 to transact business. Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Jason Nagel, Ed Boll, Richard Malott, Yvonne Malott, Brian Tatman, Megan Alley and Kevin Wiedemann.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Jason Nagel introduced himself and thanked the trustees for allowing him to attend the meeting. He said that he is the Chief Prosecuting Attorney for Clermont County and said that he is running for Municipal Court Judge in November to replace Judge Pattison who cannot run due to his age restrictions. He gave a brief history of his career and his personal life.

Megan Alley introduced herself as a reporter for the Clermont Sun. She said she is new to the area and is trying to learn more about the county and townships.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. Mr. Henning said that he followed up with Ruby Wilson regarding having a memorial service at her house for her husband and said that there are no zoning rules that would prevent that. Mr. Bainum said that Mike Pope is willing to serve on the zoning commission. Mr. Henning motioned to appoint Mike Pope to the zoning commission to fulfil the unexpired term of James Horel. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Jordan thanked Mr. Tatman for doing such a great job last week at the Patriot's Day ceremony despite the horrible rain. Mr. Tatman said that they are getting caught up with potholes while the cemetery dries out this week. He said that he got quotes for a few different mowers under the state purchasing program. He said that they have had a demo to use of a Gravely rear discharge and an Exmark rear discharge. He said that the Gravely is about \$80 cheaper, but they like the Exmark better, because the Exmark fits in between graves better and is a lot lighter and throws grass a lot better without clumping like the Gravely. Mr. Henning motioned to purchase the Exmark rear discharge from Clermont County Equipment at a cost of around \$9,359. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Tatman said that he forwarded the trustees an email regarding an attachment for the mowers that weed eat. He said that he would like for the trustees to look at this and think about it. He said that Mt. Moriah has one and he plans to go look at it. Mr. Henning asked if we needed to do any pipe work before paving Cobb Road. Mr. Tatman said that he will check them all again, but he thinks that they are all fine. He said that they are going to work on a couple of pot holes in preparation. Mr. Tatman said that we got the invoice for the \$25 membership for SWOP4G and they want to know how much salt we will need for 2015. He said that we normally ask for 100 ton, but thinks we should ask for 150 this year, because we have a little extra room for storage.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann said that the blower is not working, but he got prices on a new one and the best one he found is around \$120. Mr. Jordan motioned to buy a new blower for around \$120. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Wiedemann said that the county wants everyone to go with MDC's (Messaging Data Center). He said that he thinks we can get some MDC's from another department for a reduced cost since another township bought new ones. He said that it's possible that we will be forced to get these if the Clermont County Communication Center takes over Union Township's Communication Center. He said that he isn't sure when this will take place, but he's starting discussion on it now in case the county forces this. Mr. Wiedemann asked if we were going to purchase a new life squad this year. The trustees agreed that we are probably going to need one and asked him to start getting quotes.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:30 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
