

# Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

## August 8, 2016

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday August 8, 2016 to transact business. Chairman Bainum called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Ed Boll and Brian Tatman.

Mr. Bainum motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

### Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that we had a belly washer of a rainstorm last week. He said that there was a big problem with the culvert on Ireton Road and they will need to put in a headwall to fix the pipe. He said that they cleaned all of the pipes that needed to be cleaned, but no other long term problems to report. He said that he is still waiting on Batavia Township to call and let him know that he can borrow their boom mower, but he said that he knows there are other governments waiting to borrow it as well. He said that he's still checking on prices for tractors with boom mowers. He said that he checked on a spray license and it's a \$35 fee. Mr. Carson said that he is still waiting on a quote from the insurance company for spraying insurance. Mr. Jordan asked them to put together a sheet showing all of the chemicals that the workers are exposed to and have on hand, because it's required by law. Mr. Tatman said that it will be a good winter project to prepare and they would borrow the one from the firehouse to get started. Mr. Jordan asked how the workers were doing and he said that everyone is working together very well.

Mr. Bainum said that Mr. Wiedemann would not be at the meeting tonight, but he turned in a report on the # of runs for July. He said that he talked to the county engineer and they are hoping to pave Old State Route 32 from Batavia to Williamsburg before the end of the paving season 2016. Mr. Carson asked Mr. Tatman to call ODOT again to let them know that all of the lights are out at Half Acre Road and half of them are still out at State Route 133.

Mr. Carson said that after weeks of phone calls and emails, the paperwork is completed for the purchase of the ambulance and the ambulance would likely be finished this week and Mr. Wiedemann will probably go pick it up either this week or next.

Mr. Henning motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:20 p.m. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.
