

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

August 24, 2015

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday August 24, 2015 to transact business. Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Kevin Wiedemann, Jason Pollitt, Ed Boll, Tom Scanlon, Ron Goldston, Deputy John Schaeffer and Brian Tatman.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Zoning Report

Mr. Jordan said that Mrs. Malott is on vacation, but she left a report and no one had any questions.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that the village agreed to purchase 3 steel road plates if we purchase 3 also so that we have 6 total to share. He said that he is working on pricing and a resident offered to help get a good deal on them from a steel company, so we are waiting to see if the pricing is any better. He said that he would like to attend the American Public Works Association Snow and Ice Control Conference in Sharonville. Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the registration fee and expenses associated with this conference. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Henning said that a resident was complaining about people driving too fast on Alexander Lane. He said that he suggested that they should call the Sheriff's office and report it. The resident asked if we could put stripes down the center of the road like it used to be. Mr. Henning asked Mr. Tatman to check on pricing for striping the road. Mr. Tatman said that the 2nd weed eater attachment is on the mower and being used where it can be used. Mr. Scanlon said that he is concerned about speeders on Alexander Lane and is glad the trustees are willing to talk about putting stripes on the road.

Sheriff Report

Deputy Schaeffer said that several suspects have been captured for breaking and entering and he thinks that they burglaries are way down because they are all being ready to be prosecuted. Mr. Scanlon said that he is a self-appointed neighborhood crime watch for the Alexander Lane area and he has seen a suspicious person roaming around at night and he has tried to catch up with them but hasn't been able to catch up yet. Deputy Schaeffer said that he should call the Sheriff's office and report it the next time something happens. Mr. Boll said that he has access to a video of the person who painted the graffiti on the side of the Shell gas station and wants to email it to the Sheriff so that they can get a visual of the possible suspect.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann said that they would like to put vanities in the hallway bathrooms and to put new tile in the main hallway. He said that he got cost prices from Lowe's, Home Depot and Kibler and Kibler had the best price of around \$520 for materials and they plan to do the work themselves. He said that he has been talking to other members about what they would like to see on the new ambulance and would like to get state pricing on it so that we have an idea on what we are looking to spend. The trustees said that they'd like to see what it's going to cost and see what they are looking for.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:30 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
