

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

September 10, 2007

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday September 10, 2007 to transact business. Chairman Taylor called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Bari Henning and Jim Taylor answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson and Earl Whiteman.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting as corrected. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Henning motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Whiteman reported that Ashton Road is supposed to be paved by the end of the week. He said that Danny Bolender is going to be off work for a while, because he has pancreatic cancer and is on an IV drip for 12 hours a day. He said that he wants Mark Burba to get his CDL license and wanted to know if the township would pay for it. Mr. Henning said that he feels that Mr. Burba should pay for that himself. Mr. Taylor agreed. Mr. Whiteman said that if it is a money issue for Mr. Burba, he will pay for it, because he has paid for other employees in the past out of his own pocket. Mr. Taylor said that we received a fax from the County Engineer which gave a letter from Holiday Home's attorneys about the storm water retention ponds in the Commons of Eastfork stating that we are not liable for maintenance on them, because they are on private property. He said that he is going to run this by the county prosecutor to see if he thinks it should be revised. Mr. Henning said that he will talk to the County Engineer after we get approval on this letter.

Kristy Fishback dropped off the survey paperwork for the employees to fill out to see if they want AFLAC.

Mr. Taylor reported that Frank Harmon from Ohio Insurance Services Agency met with the employees about the changes in our insurance policy and how to fill out the paperwork involved for insurance reimbursement, etc.

Mr. Henning motioned to adjourn at approximately 8:00 p.m. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas.
