

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees

September 25, 2006

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday September 25, 2006 to transact business. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. James Danbury, Bari Henning and Jim Taylor answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson,

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Danbury second. Mr. Henning – yea. Mr. Henning – yea. Mr. Taylor – abstained. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Receipts of the meeting:

Total Receipts: \$24,370.96

Mr. Danbury motioned to pay the following bills. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas.

Total Bills: \$26,751.25

Mr. Taylor motioned to pass the resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the budget commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the county auditor. Mr. Danbury second. All yeas.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Whiteman said that they had to get 3 new tires from Auto & Truck of Williamsburg because they had broken belts in the tires on the Ford truck. While the truck was there, someone backed into the side of the truck and damaged it. He said that the other driver's insurance adjuster looked at the truck and authorized the repairs. Mr. Whiteman said that he is going to take the truck to Hughes Automotive for repairs. The trustees suggested taking it to 32 Ford if Hughes can't do it. He said that the truck is drivable, so they will be ok until the repairs can be done. He said that they no longer make the tire size that is on the Ford F550. He said that it needs front tires before winter. Mr. Danbury is concerned that if they put a different size tire on the front and don't replace the rear tires, then it might affect the 4 wheel drive. Mr. Henning said that is a question for the tire experts at the dealership. Mr. Whiteman said that they are widening Ashton Road with gravel and should be done this week. Mr. Whiteman said that the county probation department painted part of the fence at the cemetery, but didn't finish the job, so Mr. Whiteman said that his guys will finish it. He said that he has to paint some of the cemetery buildings, because they are peeling and it is galvanized steel.

Mr. Henning said that George Vaughan sent a letter resigning from the zoning board of appeals, because he is moving out of the township. Mr. Danbury motioned to accept his resignation. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mrs. Malott will take care of his replacement when she returns from vacation. Mr. Henning said that Chief Malott sent a letter to ODOT requesting turning lanes and lights at the intersection of State Route 32 and Dela Palma Road, because of the number of accidents at that intersection. Mr. Danbury said that he thinks ODOT is planning to send this out to bid in 2007 for work in 2008 according to what he remembers that ODOT told him recently. Mr. Danbury said that a few years ago, our attorney gave a description of what needed to be done to deal with solicitors, but the trustees did not act on this then, because there wasn't a problem. Mr. Henning said that he had a complaint from a resident on Ireton Road stating that a solicitor came to their house late one evening and banged on the door. They reported him to the Sheriff's Department. The trustees decided to keep an eye on this to see if it becomes a problem.

Mr. Danbury said that the Planning Commission is going to hear our zoning case ZC5-06 tomorrow evening and Mrs. Malott asked if one of the trustees would attend since she is on vacation.

Mr. Taylor motioned to set Halloween Trick or Treating for October 31 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. Mr. Danbury second. All yeas

Mr. Danbury motioned to adjourn at approximately 8:15 p.m. Mr. Taylor second. All yeas.
