

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

September 28, 2015

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday September 28, 2015 to transact business. Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Kevin Wiedemann, Brian Tatman and Megan Alley.

Mr. Bainum motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Henning motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Mr. Jordan thanked Megan Alley for the nice article in the newspaper regarding our recent FEMA grant approval. He said that our staff work hard and don't get the recognition that they deserve and thanked her for covering the news item about the grant.

Mr. Bainum said that Mrs. Malott is on vacation, but had presented a zoning report before she left. He said that the lady who bought the house next to the township hall and thanked us for having the lines painted on Alexander Lane.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that Dualite wants Cincinnati Bell Telephone to run Fioptics to their business, but the easement runs through the cemetery already for the old phone line. He said that they plan to use the existing easement and it won't disturb anything in the cemetery. The trustees agreed that since it's an existing easement, it shouldn't be a problem. Mr. Tatman said that they are in the process of repairing the roads in the Commons of Eastfork Subdivision. He said that the roads were not properly installed when built. He said that a resident in the subdivision is having a problem with cars being parked in the cul-de-sac while there is a No Parking sign in her yard. He said that he got a quote of \$5,177 for 6 steel plates and the Village is going to pay half of that cost. He said that the grass is starting to slow down, but they will have the summer help for a few more weeks.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann had Mr. Werdt come out and look at all of our emergency sirens. He said that the chargers were bad in a couple of them and they had to replace at least one battery. He said that he is visiting the ambulance company on Friday to review that they both agree on the specs. He said that they told him that prices go up in 50 days, so we need to get it ordered soon. He said that October 6 from 6-8 p.m. they are having an open house at the Emergency Services building for Fire Prevention Week. Mr. Jordan said that the Clermont County Township Association voted to have Trick or Treat on October 31 from 6-8 p.m.

Mr. Jordan said that we received the dates for the Ohio Township Association Winter Conference in January 2016. Mr. Jordan motioned to allow all elected officials and department heads to attend if they can work it into their schedules and to pay all necessary expenses. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Jordan said that the Clermont County Mental Health Department asked us to endorse their levy. Mr. Bainum motioned to endorse the Mental Health Levy. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Bainum said that the Clermont County Township Association voted to endorse the Children's Services Levy and we support that also.

Mr. Jordan motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:45 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
