

# Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

## October 10, 2011

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday October 10, 2011 to transact business. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Yvonne Malott, Vince Faris, Earl Whiteman, Deputy John Schaefer, Ed Boll and Jim Maynard.

Mr. Jordan motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.

### **Sheriff Report**

Deputy Schaefer reported that air conditioning theft is up throughout the county, but none in our township so far.

Jim Maynard asked if there was anything new on the shed at the Allison property because he said that it hasn't been moved. Mrs. Malott said that she'd have to check on it because she thought it had been moved. Mr. Maynard said that Mr. Allison isn't mowing a strip between the properties along the side of the property. She said that they only have to mow the front yard twice a year and the law doesn't apply to the back yard. Mr. Maynard asked who he should talk to about mowing the back yard. Mr. Henning explained that the state law is what we have to abide by and to get it changed; he must talk to the state rep and state Senator.

### **Cemetery & Maintenance Report**

Mr. Whiteman reported that they used eight dumpsters and one compactor truck and received about 150 tires for clean up days. He suggested keeping Randy Newberry as our part time employee through November 9 and hopes that we can keep him on call all winter and use him again part time next summer because he was a great employee. The trustees agreed that we can keep him on call if needed, but not to give him any false hope of winter work unless we really need him. Mr. Bainum said that Joe Pangallo's driveway on Todds Run Foster Road has a big slope into his driveway after they blacktopped the road. Mr. Whiteman said that he will go check it out and see if he can't put some cold patch in the driveway to help it out.

### **Zoning Report**

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. Mr. Bainum asked if the person that complained about the dog kennel at the Turkelson property was satisfied and she said that he understood that the Turkelson property is zoning agricultural and can have a dog kennel. She said that there is a fence around the pool at 4211 Eastfork Hills Drive, but it could be knocked down by a strong wind. She said that she is still trying to get them to comply. Mr. Boll said that he was up at the dumpsters late on Saturday and he found people digging in the dumpsters.

### **Emergency Services Report**

Mr. Wylie said that the health department stopped by a few weeks ago because they had an anonymous complaint that they were allowing smoking inside the emergency services building. He said that he is designating outside smoking areas outside as required by ORC. Mr. Wylie said that he is still checking on prices for batteries for the weather sirens. Mr. Malott said that he asked about fixing the 2 generators at the fire house that aren't working. He said that he would like to try to fix them and the trustees agreed. Jayne Lawrence said that the address for 235 Happy Lane is wrong and it should be 235 Nevels Drive. Mr. Henning said that he will have Mrs. Malott look into it for zoning.

Mr. Jordan motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:50 p.m. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.
