

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

October 12, 2009

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday October 12, 2009 to transact business. Vice Chairman Bainum called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum and Bari Henning answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Richard Malott, Yvonne Malott, Ed Boll, Earl Whiteman and Deputy John Schaeffer.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Sheriff Report

Deputy Schaeffer said that everything is pretty much the status quo.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Whiteman said that some people damaged several pumpkins that people had placed on the graves and he filed a police report. He said that they need a set of straps to move headstones and they are about \$60. The trustees told him to get them. He said that six dumpsters and one compactor truck were used for junk days. Mr. Bainum said that Tom Fisher asked him if they could separate things at the dumpsters such as batteries rather than just throw everything in the dumpsters. Mr. Whiteman said that Mr. Fisher gave him a skid to put batteries on, but we don't accept batteries, so no one brought any. He said that we received about 80 tires and he has called the county to take them away. Mr. Henning said that he talked to someone who said that our staff was very helpful during junk days and complimented them for their help and politeness. He said that all of the equipment is up and running.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. She said that the guy from Juwi Solar will be here on Friday to meet with a couple of zoning members if they are available to talk about zoning rules for their proposed solar farm. She said that he has a few minor concerns that he wants to discuss with us. Mr. Bainum said that he was very happy that Chief Malott was honored as the grand marshal for the homecoming parade and thought it was very neat. Mr. Henning said that he went to Joe Berger's with Mr. Bainum to follow up on the complaints on his property. He said that they explained what needed to be done to comply with our zoning and if he didn't do it, our zoning would have to take it to the next step with what needs to be done by the law.

Mr. Bainum said that we received a few resumes for the fire chief job and we'll continue to receive them until November 1 and then decide what the next step will be. Mr. Henning said that the job ad was placed in the Community Journal, Enquirer and Careerbuilder.com and it's posted on our website. Mr. Henning said that he needs information for the newsletter very soon and it will be mailed out in November. Mr. Bainum said that our monthly township association meeting is at the Sheriff's office this Thursday.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Malott said that he found some unclaimed funds from 2000 in the amount of about \$200, but he is jumping through paperwork hoops to try to get this money.

Mr. Henning motioned to adjourn at approximately 8:05 p.m. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.
