

# Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

## November 9, 2015

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday November 9, 2015 to transact business. Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Yvonne Malott, Ed Boll and Richard Malott.

Mr. Bainum motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

### Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. She reported that the bank had taken care of mowing 4002 Alexander Lane and it looked much better. She said that she was grateful that Mr. Tatman had put up a new mailbox and it was destroyed about a week later, so he put up another new one after Halloween and it hasn't been destroyed yet. Mr. Jordan asked if there was anything in the zoning book regarding noise ordinances and she said no. Mr. Jordan said that he has talked to the township association about it also and they don't have anything either.

Mr. Jordan said that Chief Wiedemann was attending his daughter's sports awards night at school and he felt that he was in the correct place. He said that Mr. Tatman is attending an advanced EMT class tonight. He said that Mr. Tatman turned in quotes to fix West Fork Ridge Drive at a cost of \$8,594 from Houck Asphalt. Mr. Henning motioned to hire Houck Asphalt to fix the paving on West Fork Ridge Drive at a cost of around \$8,594. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. He said that Mr. Tatman turned in quotes to fix East Fork Valley Drive at a cost of \$6,496 from Houck Asphalt. Mr. Bainum motioned to hire Houck Asphalt to fix the paving on East Fork Valley Drive at a cost of around \$6,496. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. He said that Mr. Tatman reported that the summer help is done working for the summer. Mr. Bainum said that a resident asked if we could look at the school bus turn around on Cobb Road because the gravel needs some repairs and he asked Mr. Tatman to look at it. Mr. Malott asked about a big hole in the berm at the corner of Cobb Road and Dela Palma Road. Mr. Henning said that Mr. Tatman was planning to berm the entire road now that it's been paved, but hasn't completed it yet. Mr. Malott asked about the small section at the intersection area of State Route 32 and Dela Palma Road that wasn't paved a couple of years ago when they paved it. Mr. Henning said that the county agreed that they missed it and would fix it when back in the area a couple of years ago. After paving Cobb Road the county paved the small area of Dela Palma on the north side of SR 32 but for some unknown reason failed to pave the small area on the south side of SR 32.

Mr. Jordan said that the county township association monthly meeting is at our Emergency Services building this month and Mr. Bainum said that he would take care of getting the supplies and ordering the food.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:30 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
