

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

November 15, 2010

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday November 15, 2010 to transact business for a special meeting to review the handbook of policies and procedures. Chairman Bainum called the meeting to order at 6:45 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present was Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson.
