

# Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

## November 24, 2014

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday November 24, 2014 to transact business. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Kevin Wiedemann, Brian Tatman, Ken Wylie, Ed Boll, Yvonne Malott and Richard Malott.

Mr. Jordan motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.

### **Zoning Report**

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. She said that she is still working with Mr. Johnson to finish cleaning his property. She said he has a lot more to do on it, but he has been making slow improvements. She said that Mr. Milton has a huge pile of appliances that are piling up. The trustees asked her to ask Mr. Milton to clean them up. Mrs. Malott said that the zoning office will be closed on Thanksgiving and the day after. She said that she goes to court mediation for the property at 4302 East Fork Valley Drive. She said that she is having problems with parcel #52-44-41.001. The property is listed as 3966 Sally Drive on the Auditor's website and the Communications Center; however the Batavia Post Office changed the address to 3966 State Route 133. She said that she is working on clearing up the issue. She said that there are a couple of other addresses that have been issues over the years and the Batavia post office is hard to deal with.

### **Cemetery & Maintenance Report**

Mr. Tatman said that we had our first snowfall last week and we used about 3 tons of salt. He said that he called Kaffenbarger and "supposedly" we are still on track for delivery soon on the new truck during the first week of December. He asked the trustees if they could get new coveralls for the 2 employees as their current ones are in very poor condition. Mr. Jordan motioned to allow them to purchase 2 sets of coveralls. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

### **Emergency Services Report**

Mr. Wiedemann said that they have had lots of problems with the squad this past week. They replace 2 sensors and it had lost 8 quarts of oil, but they fixed these issues and it seems fine for now. He said that they are keeping a close eye on it now and hopefully it's just a fluke. Mr. Wylie said that starting in January there is a firefighter 1 class in Bethel and they want to send Joe Morgan and the cost is around \$800, but they can get the money back from a grant. He said that Mr. Morgan is now 18 and he has been a cadet for a long time and he's a hard worker.

Mr. Boll said that the recycle bins next to the cemetery were overflowing. Mr. Tatman said that they are in the village, but he knows that they are dumped twice a week.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:35 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
