

# Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

## May 8, 2017

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday May 8, 2017 to transact business. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Yvonne Malott, Richard Malott, Kevin Wiedemann, Brian Tatman and Ed Boll.

Mr. Bainum motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

### Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. Mr. Bainum asked about the people living at the church on State Route 133. Mr. Wiedemann said that he has heard that it's possibly the pastor of the church that is living there. Mrs. Malott said that she is waiting for our assistant prosecutor Ernie Ramos to get back from vacation so that she can ask him how to handle it since it's not zoned residential and people can't live there. Mr. Henning said that there is a property on Bootjack Road near Coon Town that is vacant and has lots of stuff sitting around. She said that it's up for Sheriff's auction soon.

### Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that he is still waiting for the adjuster to give him information on the roof at the township hall. He said that Perry Bennett passed out on the job last week and 911 was called, but he seems to be doing fine now and the doctor has released him to come back to work. He said that he has handed out a few applications for people to work part time at the cemetery but no one has turned them back in yet. Mr. Bainum said that Gary Smith from Ireton Road has asked about the tree near his house that needs to be taken care of and Mr. Tatman said that he has it on his list to do, but he's been extremely busy and he plans to get it soon. Mr. Jordan reminded Mr. Tatman that the Aramark Contract ends on May 12.

### Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann said that Duke Energy wants to give him a quote on replacing all of the lights in the emergency services building. Trustees said that it's good to get a quote to see what it will show. Mr. Wiedemann said that he is losing 2 medics temporarily for a surgery and maternity leave. He said that a 3<sup>rd</sup> medic may be having eye surgery also so he may have to fill in quite a bit and may need to miss some upcoming township trustee meetings. He said that the ambulance hit a deer on the way back from the hospital last week. He said that the bumper is bent and the headlight is broken, but he thinks that he can replace the broken parts in house since it's likely under the deductible. Mr. Wiedemann said that he wants to participate in a ride along program with US Grant Joint Vocational School and Bethel Tate Fire Department. He said that it's a good program for us to teach to potential new members. Mr. Henning motioned to sign the Educational Clinical Agreement between US Grant Joint Vocational School and Bethel Tate Fire Department. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:30 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
