

# Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

## November 27, 2017

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday November 27, 2017 to transact business. Chairman Henning called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Richard Malott, Yvonne Malott, Deputy John Schaefer, Ed Boll, Brian Tatman and Kevin Wiedemann.

Mr. Bainum motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Henning motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Deputy John Schaefer gave a copy of the crime statistics for all of the townships in the county. He said that it's pretty quiet in Williamsburg Township which is a good thing for our township. He said that the homeless problem is getting pretty bad around the area of Batavia Township's Bauer Road. He said that unless they are breaking the law, there isn't much that they can do. Mr. Boll said that he had a homeless person who was a sexual predator living in a tent on his property last summer and the Sheriff would just ask them to leave his property. He said that about a month ago, a person on a John Deere Gator was pulling a pipe out of the ditch and he called and filed a report and the Owensville PD and Sheriff came. He said that he doesn't know if they did anything with it or not.

### Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. She said that someone asked about junk days. Mr. Henning said that it will likely be in June 2018, but Mr. Tatman would work on setting a date with Rumpke sometime in early 2018.

Mr. Henning reminded everyone that the only meeting in December would be December 18, 2017 at 7 p.m.

### Cemetery and Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that they are working on cutting back brush along the roads. He said that they hoped to finish mowing the cemetery this week since the weather is still nice. He said that they are getting ready to work on the ditch on Bass Road that has a problem. He said that they might mow the township hall yard one more time to mulch leaves.

### Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann said that he started to run electric today for the new gear extractor machine that is coming. He said that 3 of the furnaces are installed already and they have a couple more to go. Mr. Henning asked Mr. Wiedemann to update the wage survey of other departments so that we can prepare for our next meeting with raises.

Mr. Bainum said that he met with Ernie Ramos from the Prosecutor's office regarding the cemetery bequests and they think that there will be some court work, but hopefully they can clear up the bequests. He said that the Trains of Williamsburg Christmas Walk in Williamsburg is this Friday night.

Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:25 p.m. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.
