

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

May 29, 2018

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday May 29, 2018 to transact business. Chairman Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Richard Malott, Ed Boll, Kevin Wiedemann and Brian Tatman.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. The trustees said that she was attending a zoning board meeting in the back room this evening at the same time as our meeting. Mr. Jordan motioned that 2879 Old State Route 32 be declared a nuisance pursuant to ORC 505.87 due to high grass and vegetation and to make the proper notifications regarding being mowed or it will be mowed and the taxes will be assessed. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Henning said that the cemetery looked very nice for the Memorial Day weekend and he had several compliments from residents regarding how good it looked. Mr. Tatman said that they are starting to mow roads. He said that Junk Days are June 7-9. He said that he got an email that salt bids will be sent out the week of June 18. He said that he had 1 request for road bids from Barrett Paving, but no one turned in a bid tonight by 7 p.m. as requested in the bid package. The trustees asked Mr. Tatman to contact the county engineer to see how they would handle this situation since they provided the initial estimate. Mr. Carson said that he'd contact the county prosecutor to see what we need to do to rebid it. Mr. Bainum said that the owner of 4226 East Fork Hills Drive contacted him about the road damage that he thinks is being caused by the garbage truck. Mr. Tatman said that he looked at a similar issue up the road from this and he will do some patching this summer.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann said that the 2009 ambulance broke down over the weekend, but we still have 2 squads in service. He said that he wants to send 3 people to a firefighter I class that will cost about \$875 per person. He said that they normally get the money back from a grant. Mr. Henning motioned to send 3 people to the Firefighter I class at a cost of \$875/each. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Wiedemann said that he's trying to take some vacation soon. He said that he's actively working to get staff ready for the July 1 change to 24/7. Mr. Boll said that State Route 276 is going to be closed next week for about a week to replace a culvert.

Mr. Jordan said that the county commissioners sent a letter notifying us that they have raised the motor vehicle license tax by \$5.00 effective January 1, 2019 to collect extra money for road repairs in the county. He said that we received an invitation to the Clermont County Public Library Williamsburg branch to an open house on June 23 at 2 p.m. Mr. Bainum said that a member of the Baptist Church next to the property on State Route 133 airport by Bootjack and State Route 133 is concerned about helicopters or airplanes crashing into their church. Mr. Bainum said that he assured the member that the changes to the zoning code would be minor and shouldn't cause any disruptions. He said that he has asked a couple of people about the zoning board and they are considering joining, but haven't committed yet.

Mr. Jordan motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:50 p.m. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.
