

# Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

## March 11, 2019

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday March 11, 2019 to transact business. Chairperson Bainum called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum and Bari Henning answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Yvonne Malott, Richard Malott, Kevin Wiedemann, Brian Tatman, Ed Boll and John McGraw.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Bainum motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Mr. Bainum said that Mr. Jordan was out of town for a business meeting for work tonight.

Mr. McGraw said that he's interested in running for County Commissioner in 2020 and was here to listen to the concerns of our township.

### Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. She said that she is retiring on August 31, 2019, because that is her 20 year anniversary in OPERS. Mr. Bainum said that Mrs. Bruns on Bootjack Road called and asked about putting a barn to host wedding receptions, parties, etc. He said that he asked her to call Mrs. Malott to see about the zoning requirements.

### Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that he plans to order one more load of salt and that will fulfill our required purchases with the vendor and it will fill all our barns up completely. He said that he plans to start cold patching again this week, because the weather has been harsh this year on the roads. Mr. Henning said that the county told him that they aren't able to help us piggyback with them for paving this year. He said that we want to look at Hageman's Crossing and Hibbs Road this year. He asked Mr. Tatman to ask the county to give us their estimate so that we can prepare the bids. Mr. Boll asked about ODOT work on State Route 276. Mr. Tatman said that ODOT plans to close State Route 276 for 28 days to replace a big bridge/culvert and then pave the entire road from Williamsburg to Owensville.

### Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann gave a copy of the stats for February. He said that the county informed them at the last Chief's meeting that they are upgrading the CAD system again. He said that we would need to upgrade all of the computers and the initial estimate is around \$23,000, but he'll have a better quote at the next meeting. He said that we have 9 old air pack units that we no longer use and a smaller township fire department asked if we would be willing to donate it to them. The trustees agreed that if we are no longer using them, then they are willing to donate them to a small township that can use them. Mr. Wiedemann gave a copy of a note from his doctor releasing him to light duty until April 1. Mr. Henning said that we don't have light duty work available for a firefighter, so we won't be able to bring him back until he's released to full duty.

Mr. Bainum said that the Clermont County Health Department is having their annual health meeting for the township association on March 21 and he will RSVP for all 3 trustees. He said that we received a letter from Clermont County notifying us of different parcels for which the Village of Williamsburg plans to annex and the County Commissioners will have a public hearing on May 29. The parcels are Doug Durham on Sally Drive, John Wendell on Main Street, Deborah Gabbard on 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Mary Hanawalt on 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Frank Pittman on 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Tayler Davis on 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Christopher Raby on St. Rt. 133, HD Milton on St. Rt. 133 and Verna Goecke on St. Rt. 276. Mr. Bainum said that he plans to attend the Village of Williamsburg meeting on Thursday to ask about some recognition on the honor board. Mr. Wiedemann said that the Village changed the meeting to last Thursday so he'll have to wait until the next time.

Mr. Henning motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:30 p.m. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.
