

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

March 25, 2019

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday March 25, 2019 to transact business. Chairperson Bainum called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Yvonne Malott, Ed Boll, Kevin Wiedemann and Brian Tatman.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. She said that she had calls from Township residence concerned about the Rumpke Refuse Receptacles being dropped off onto their driveways. Emergency Services Report

Chief Wiedemann said that he got the quote for three computer updates that the Clermont County Communications Center required for the Department and they need to be updated by April 1, 2019 at a cost of \$13,289.00. Mr. Henning motioned to update 3 computers as required by the Clermont County Communications Center from Mobile TEK Consulting. Mr. Jordan second. All Yeas. Chief Wiedemann said that he will have the camera quote for the next meeting.

Maintenance & Cemetery Report

Mr. Tatman reminded the Trustees that he would be in Columbus for a Grant writing meeting. Mr. Tatman said he would have a meeting with Mr. Ely on Tuesday March 26 to get estimates on paving Hibbs Road and Hageman's Road and will have the information for the next Township Trustees meeting. He said that the gravel at culvert on Henning's Mill Road had washed out and also the culvert on Hibbs Road, so will be putting slurry and stone down on Henning's Mill Road. He asked if he could have Mr. Bennett back as summer part time beginning April 1st. Trustees agreed. He said that they have been cleaning up debris for winds the last few weeks at all cemeteries. Mr. Jordan asked if Mr. Tatman had contacted Mrs. Fee concerning the water backup for the front ditch on Old State Route 32. Mr. Tatman said he has been in contact with her and the Clermont County Engineer Office.

Mr. Bainum said the annexation of a few properties to the Village of Williamsburg are being drawn up and will presented when attorneys have finished. Mr. Jordan brought up that an article in the Clermont Sun by Brett Milan had incorrectly had the "Williamsburg Township Trustees have a case against Dollar General located on 4180 State Route 276". It is the Village of Williamsburg. Mr. Jordan will contact Mr. Milam to have correction made on the next issue of the Clermont Sun.
