

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

April 8, 2019

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday April 8, 2019 to transact business. Chairperson Bainum called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Gregory W. Carson, Tracy Hurst, Susan Ellerhorst, Kevin Wiedemann, Richard Malott, Yvonne Malott, Brian Tatman and Ed Boll.

Mr. Henning motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Tracy Hurst from the June in Olde Williamsburgh Committee said that the event has been going on since 1996 and described all of the fun events that they are having this year. She said that they haven't been able to have fireworks for the past couple of years, because of costs, but they have a quote of \$6,600 for this year and would like for the township, village and committee to split the costs by 1/3 or about \$2,200. The trustee said that they would think about it and let them know.

Zoning Report

Mrs. Malott presented a zoning report. Mr. Jordan said that there have been some concerns about people who can't handle the cans and want to only have bags. Mr. Bainum asked about Mr. Lovett, because he may want to have a POD or a semi-trailer to store stuff for moving. Mrs. Malott said that PODS are legal, because they are temporary. Mr. Bainum asked about the property next to the Duke Energy power plant by WJAA, because it's looking very bad. Mrs. Malott said that they had done everything that could legally be done according to the prosecutor.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman said that he inspected Todd's Run, because Mr. Bainum had called to let him know that someone was worried about a spot on the edge. Mr. Tatman said that there is no berm in this corner location and they have tried to berm it over the years and it always washes away. He said that he is working on the ODOT grant for signs and he said that they need to do speed checks on every curve in the township. He said that it must be turned in by June 7, so they are working on gathering the information. Mr. Tatman said that he talked to the county about blacktopping Hibbs Road and Hageman's Crossing Road. They suggested that we go with 1" of 404 blacktop v/s the 1.5" of 448 that ODOT recommended a few years ago. The county will prepare us an official estimate so that we can move forward. Mr. Henning motioned to advertise for bids for paving of Hageman's Crossing and Hibbs Road. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.

Mr. Henning said that he's putting together the newsletter and wants everyone to get their reports before the next meeting.

Mr. Jordan motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:30 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
