

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

July 13, 2020

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday July 13, 2020 to transact business. Chairperson Henning called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Brian Tatman, Ed Boll, Bobby Feimsler, Dylan Arnett and Kevin Wiedemann.

Mr. Henning said that Mr. Bainum was on vacation. He said that Mr. Carson is representing Williamsburg Township at the Clermont Chamber of Commerce Salute to Leaders event awarding our Williamsburg Township honoree, David Caudill.

Mr. Henning said that we would have to table the minutes of the last meeting since he wasn't there and Mr. Bainum isn't here tonight.

Mr. Jordan motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.

Zoning Report

Mr. Tatman presented a zoning report. Mr. Jordan asked Mr. Tatman to check and see if someone was living in a camper in the general area of where we are located. Mr. Tatman said he would check into it and take the appropriate actions.

Emergency Services Report

Chief Wiedemann is ordering all township employees including trustees and fiscal officer 3m mask, with money from the Cares Act. He advised that the UV lights have come in and he has started to use them in the Emergency Services Building already. He also has brought 6 of them to Township hall to be used in it. The Township has received mask from the county to hand out to residents that need them. Residents can come to the Emergency Services Building between 8 am and 5pm Monday thru Friday to pick them up for the people in their house hold.

Cemetery & Maintenance Report

Mr. Tatman asked if there were any questions or concerns about the report he presented. Mr. Jordan advised Mr. Tatman he may want to check with Mr. Earley and make sure when school was starting and how the buses would be running so we can have all the roads trimmed back from brush before school starts. Asked Mr. Tatman to make sure all the school bus turn arounds were ready also. Mr. Henning asked how much trouble it would be to move the radar sign maybe weekly instead of leaving it on the same road for long periods. Mt. Tatman said he would get it moved every 7 to 10 days when possible. Mr. Jordan mentioned if we hear of the radar sign coming down in price we may want to look into getting another one.

Mr. Jordan advised Mr. Tatman and Chief Wiedemann that he would like them to get into some leadership classes to help them advance in their leadership roles.

Mr. Henning brought up that the JEDD in the South Afton Industrial park is good for the township. Mr. Henning said he would like to see Fiscal Officer Greg Carson investigate to see if there were any more areas that would be best suited to have a JEDD put in place in Williamsburg Township. Mr. Jordan agreed. Mr. Henning made a motion to appoint and give Greg Carson authority to speak with a Jedd lawyer about the matter. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.

Mr. Henning said in years past we have helped Harmony Hill with a donation of some kind. He said they are great for the community because they share the history of Williamsburg with the younger generation. Mr. Henning made a motion to donate \$2500 to Harmony Hill. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.

Mr. Jordan motioned to adjourn at approximately 7:40 p.m. Mr. Henning second. All yeas.
