

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

May 24, 2021

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees met on Monday May 24, 2021 to transact business. Chairperson Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Brian Tatman, Kevin Wiedemann, Ed Boll, Bobby Feimster & Dillion Arnett.

Mr. Bainum motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Henning second. All yeas. Mr. Carson presented a financial report, including a comprehensive account of expenditures and receipts and the trustees accepted it.

Mr. Henning motioned to pay the attached bills. Mr. Bainum second. All yeas.

Zoning Report

Mr. Tatman asked if there were any questions about the zoning report. Mr. Henning asked if the guy selling flags had been back out at Dela Palma. Mr. Tatman said yes, he had been out there on Sunday May 23, 2021. Mr. Tatman said he was by there today and he was not out selling flags. He will check every day for next couple of weeks even over the weekend. Mr. Jordan said we may want to revisit the roadside stand issue again at the end of the year and make some changes to the resolution book. Said it is a safety issue at the 32 corridor interchanges. Mr. Jordan asked Chief Wiedemann how many crashes have occurred over the last year at 32 and Dela Palma and 32 and McKeever. Chief Wiedemann said there was 10 at 32 and Dela Palma and 5 at 32 and McKeever.

Maintenance & Cemetery Report

Mr. Tatman presented an application from Skylar Gries to work part time for the summer. He said he graduates this year. Mr. Henning made motion to hire Skylar Gries, Mr. Bainum second. Roll Call yeas. Memorial Day Parade is on for this year, Line up is at 11:00 am parade to start at 11:30 am. Mr. Henning brought up about the circle or island on West Fork Ridge Drive. He said he has had several residence calls and ask about taking it out. Mr. Henning drove down and looked at it. Said it is an eye sore. Mr. Henning said to get some bids to have it taken out and blacktopped.

Emergency Services Report

Mr. Wiedemann said the EMS billing contract was up this year, asked did they want him to sign it or bring it in for the trustee to sign. They said for him to go ahead and sign the contract. Mr. Wiedemann advised the tower should be back soon. He said the cylinders had to be rebuilt on it. He also said one of the squads will be going to get tires on it soon.

Mr. Jordan said Mr. Ramos retirement part is June 3 from 11 am-1 pm. He said we do not know who will be taking his place yet.
