

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

February 28, 2024

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees held a Special Session on Wednesday, February 28, 2024 at the Williamsburg Township Hall, for the following purpose: to continue to discuss ideas for a five-year plan and all other matters that may come before the Board in open session. Mr. Jordan called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Bari Henning, and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer, Doug Lefferson, Maintenance Supervisor/Zoning Administrator Brian Tatman and Emergency Services Chief Jason McCarthy.

The Trustees and Mr. Lefferson, Chief McCarthy, and Mr. Tatman brainstormed elements that should be involved in a five-year strategic plan for the Township. The Trustees decided to form a Brand Subcommittee to review brand options for the Township which would include design elements of logos, signage, etc. The committee would be comprised of Trustee Guy Bainum, Fiscal Officer Lefferson, Emergency Services Chief McCarthy, Maintenance Supervisor/Zoning Inspector Brian Tatman, and a representative from the community at large. Mr. Bainum said he had some ideas of some community members who had the appropriate skill sets and would reach out to them to gauge interest. The Trustees also decided to hold additional planning sessions.

There being no further business, Mr. Bainum motioned to adjourn at approximately 11:30 a.m. Mr. Jordan second. All yeas.
