

Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees Minutes

June 2, 2026

The Williamsburg Township Board of Trustees held a Special Meeting on Tuesday, June 2, 2026 at the Williamsburg Township Hall. The purpose of the Special Meeting was to consider confidential information related to economic development, and all other matters that may come before the Board. Mr. Jordan called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m., and all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Guy Bainum, Charlie Maklem, and Gary Jordan answered the roll call. Also present were Fiscal Officer Doug Lefferson, Emergency Services Chief Jason McCarthy, Ed Boll, Scott Gafvert, Joel Gross, Chris Rowland, and Jim Halterman.

There was no public participation.

Mr. Maklem motioned to go into Executive Session pursuant to ORC 121.22 (G)(8) to consider negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development and the information is directly related to ORC 5709.73 and involves public infrastructure improvements or the extension of utility services that are directly related to an economic development project; and the Board has determined that the executive session is necessary to protect the interests in regard to the possible investment or expenditure of public funds to be made in connection with the economic development project, at approximately 1:01 p.m. Mr. Bainum second.
